Please complete this form and present it to your advisor. Turn in the completed form and signed advising card to the Office of Student Affairs.

Summer

_____ Check if you will enroll in one or more courses during the summer. If you will not, you can skip to the "Fall" section below.

_____ Check that you understand that you cannot enroll in more than two courses in each of Summer Sessions I and II. (The intersession course in *International Commercial Arbitration* does not count against the 2-course limits for Sessions I and II.)

_____ Check that you understand you cannot graduate earlier than the end of the fall semester of your third year even if you accumulate 90 credits before the start of that semester.

Fall

_____ Please enter the number of credits you expect to have successfully completed by end of the Summer 2008.

_____ Please enter the number of remaining credits which you will have to complete after summer 2008 in order to graduate. (A minimum of 90 credits is required, but at least 68 of these must be grades of C or above. Credits can be counted only once for purposes of the 90-credit requirement even if you have taken a course more than once.)

_____ Please enter the number of credits for which you intend to register in Fall 2008. (You must register for a minimum of 12 and a maximum of 16 credits unless you receive permission from Dean Miller to do otherwise. The ABA limits you to no more than 18 hours from classes in any semester.)

_____ Every student should read and check this box, indicating that you understand that you will be dismissed if you accumulate grades below C in more than 22 credits by the end of the Fall semester of your third year.

Note: Please check any of the following which may apply:

_____ Your cumulative GPA is currently less than 2.15. If so, you must schedule an advising meeting with Professor Carlton Bailey, who has been specially designated to advise students who may find themselves in academic difficulty. You must also meet with Dean Jim Miller.

_____ You have earned more than 8 credits of grades below a "C". If so, you must be advised by Professor Carlton Bailey. You must also meet with Dean Jim Miller.

_____ Your cumulative GPA is currently less than 2.05. If so, only Professor Bailey may sign your advising card. You must also meet with Dean Jim Miller.

_____ You expect to have earned grades below a "C" in more than 15 credits by the end of the Summer semester. If so, only Professor Bailey may sign your advising card. You must also meet with Dean Jim Miller.

_____ You intend to register for any courses other than LAW classes for J.D. credit. If so, you must see Dean Adams in order to obtain approval for such classes. If the class is one offered in the LLM program, you must see the Director of the LLM program.

_____ You will not register for Legal Research and Writing III during Fall 2008. This course must be taken prior to graduation, and you are strongly encouraged to take it before the end of your second year.

_____ You will not have completed Constitutional Law by the end of Summer 2008. This course must be taken prior to graduation.

_____ You will not register for Professional Responsibility during Fall 2008. This course must be taken prior to graduation and is a prerequisite to all Clinic courses.

_____ You will not have completed the skills requirement by the end of Summer 2008. You must complete this requirement prior to graduation. The eligible courses are designated on the schedule.
