The major antitrust laws in the United States are the Sherman Act,<sup>1</sup> Clayton Act,<sup>2</sup> Capper-Volstead Act,<sup>3</sup> Federal Trade Commission Act,<sup>4</sup> Hart-Scott-Rodino Antitrust Improvements Act,<sup>5</sup> and the Packers and Stockyards Act.<sup>6</sup>

Prepare for a career in antitrust law by taking classes, participating in specialized educational programs, and learning on your own. Career opportunities in this area of the law include federal and state government, corporate practice, private practice, and policy organizations. Fellowships and internship opportunities are also available.

# Law School Classes for Skills in Antitrust Law Practice

To build skills for a career in antitrust law, law students may be interested in the following classes:

## Antitrust Law

A course dedicated to antitrust law covers the concepts of concentration, monopoly, price-fixing, cartels, unreasonable restraints on trade, mergers and acquisitions, and the statutes, regulations, and cases in this area.

## Public Corporations

A course on public corporations provides knowledge of how corporations are governed, regulated, and may include mergers and acquisitions.

## Mergers and Acquisitions

A mergers and acquisition course covers topics on business transactions, due diligence assessments, regulatory requirements, shareholder rights, and director duties throughout a merger or acquisition.

## Food or Agricultural Law

A course on Agricultural or Food Law may discuss important industry basics and cover the Packers and Stockyards Act, which is a competition and market regulation law specific to the meat and poultry industries.

## Legal Research and Writing

Legal research and writing skills are essential to any law practice, but especially important for antitrust law. Learning how to read and analyze statutes, regulations, and case law is crucial for writing strong legal arguments in this area.

## Contracts

Usually a required course, knowledge of contract law is important because many antitrust disputes involve contracts.

## Criminal Law

Knowledge of criminal law and procedure is beneficial for any antitrust law practice. Whether prosecuting, defending, or advising for corporate compliance, antitrust law includes aspects of criminal law. In addition, criminal law classes would teach valuable skills for criminal investigations and evidence gathering to prosecute or defend antitrust allegations.

## Administrative Law

Many aspects of antitrust law involve federal and state regulatory agencies. Knowledge of administrative law and process is essential for an antitrust law practice.

## Corporate Compliance

A corporate compliance class would be beneficial for in-house counsel representation. Learning how to interpret regulations, mitigate risk, and create a compliance program are essential to a successful practice in this area.

## Torts

Knowledge of tort law is also beneficial for any antitrust law practice.

## Business Organizations

A course on business organizations provides basic knowledge of how different businesses are formed and governed. Antitrust claims typically involve businesses.



# Specialized Programs

Specialized programs can provide students and practitioners with additional knowledge and skills in the areas of antitrust and food and agricultural law. LL.M. programs in antitrust law and LL.M. programs with specialized courses in antitrust law are options. The LL.M. Program in Agricultural and Food Law at the University of Arkansas School of Law offers a variety of specialized courses including “Selected Issues in Agricultural and Food Law: Competition and Antitrust” which covers federal antitrust issues in food and agricultural industries.<sup>7</sup>

# Federal and State Government

**Federal agencies including the U.S. Department of Justice Antitrust Division, Federal Trade Commission and the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Agricultural Marketing Service's Packers and Stockyards Division work to enforce antitrust laws.** <sup>8</sup>

### U.S. Department of Justice Antitrust Division

The U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) Antitrust Division is involved in civil enforcement and criminal enforcement of antitrust laws. <sup>9</sup>

### Federal Trade Commission

The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) was created by the Federal Trade Commission Act in 1914. <sup>10</sup> The FTC develops policy, issues rules, creates educational programs, and enforces the law to protect consumers "from deceptive or unfair business practices and from unfair methods of competition."<sup>11</sup>

The DOJ and FTC work together to enforce antitrust laws in mergers and acquisitions. <sup>12</sup>

### U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS) Packers and Stockyards Division (PSD)

The Packers and Stockyards Division (PSD) enforces the Packers and Stockyards Act by monitoring the industry, conducting investigations, and using administrative and court actions for enforcement. The PSD also may refer cases to the U.S. DOJ for enforcement.<sup>13</sup>

### State Offices of the Attorney General

State offices of the attorney general can enforce federal and state antitrust laws.<sup>14</sup> State attorney general offices can also bring actions on behalf of their citizens who may "have been harmed by an antitrust violation and recover damages for those citizens under federal antitrust law."<sup>15</sup>

# Private Practice

### Litigation

An attorney in private practice may represent clients in bringing or defending antitrust cases. This may involve investigating allegations and filing a complaint on behalf of a plaintiff or responding to a complaint and defending a client through the litigation process.

### Mergers and Acquisitions

A mergers and acquisitions practice involves preparing and filing documents with regulatory agencies, performing "due diligence" assessments, and advising clients on regulatory issues.<sup>16</sup>

### Cooperatives

An attorney in private practice may represent cooperatives. A cooperative is an "association of members of a similar profession or industry that work together" in various ways.<sup>17</sup> Cooperatives are usually organized so their members have equal voting power and they exist for the mutual benefit of their members.<sup>18</sup> Special tax benefits can apply to cooperatives.<sup>19</sup> Representation of a cooperative may involve drafting and filing documents to set up the cooperative and making sure the organization maintains its status and stays in compliance with the law.

### Corporations

An attorney in private practice may represent a corporation as a private attorney or in-house counsel. Representing a corporation may involve drafting documents, litigation, mergers and acquisitions, and/or compliance.

Employment opportunities for corporate representation may exist in industries including grocery, food manufacturing, and agriculture.
