Law Professor Says Paterno Treated Unfairly

STATE COLLEGE, CENTRE COUNTY - A new report written by a professor of law in Arkansas says the state grand jury crossed a line by even mentioning Joe Paterno in their investigation of Jerry Sandusky.

University of Arkansas Professor Brian Gallini wrote that regardless of how Paterno handled information about Sandusky his name should not have been part of the public document, because it was only an investigation of Sandusky, not Paterno or the university.

He says this grand jury report named witnesses and other people who were not being investigated, and didn't give them a chance to defend themselves.
